- Don't Forget To Show Gratitude.



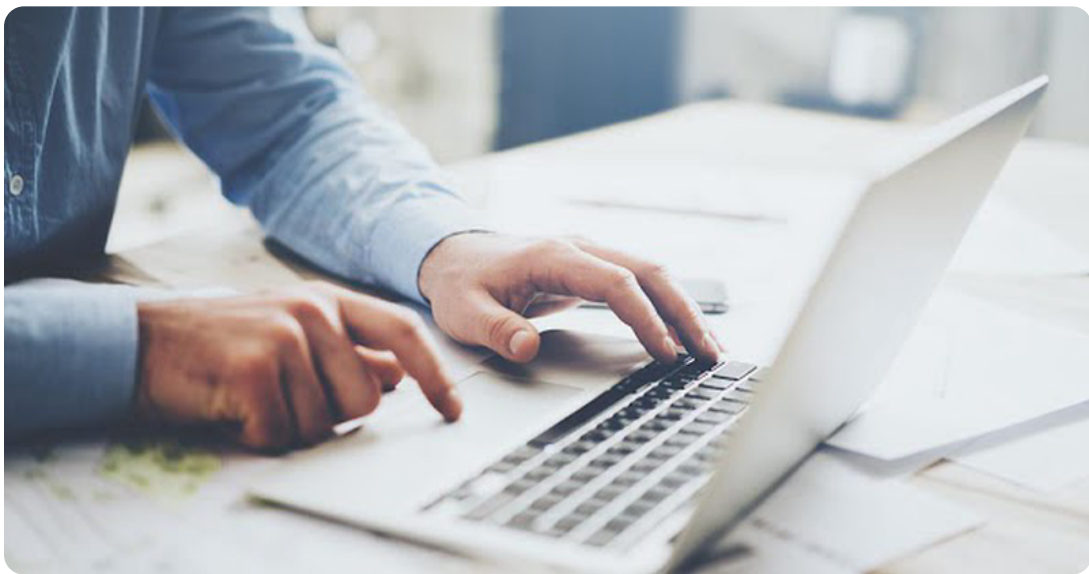


Step 5
