## The Average Cost of Inpatient Addiction Treatment and Recovery

The cost of addiction treatment can be unbearable for most people. For example, a typical inpatient addiction treatment in an average American City can cost between \$17,000 and \$27,000 for a 30-day program. Likewise, life after rehab can be challenging because there might not be a job or a home to go to. Also, the recovering addict might have challenges with family members or might have problems that requires money. How can an average person get this money when there are several other items to require money? It is worth learning that financially challenged people with alcohol/drug problems can receive financial help for drug treatment and recovery from some reputable organizations. These organizations include:

#### **States Government**

State governments in the United States have various joint venture partnerships that aim at caring for people with a form of addiction. For example, the Substance Abuse Prevention and Treatment Block Grant (SABG), which is administered by the Center for Substance Abuse Prevention (CSAP) in the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA), enables state governments to provide substance abuse treatment, recovery support services as well as substance abuse prevention programs.

Like many states, Michigan uses part of this fund to facilitate initiatives for youths, women, and other vulnerable groups. The program for youths is known as the Michigan Youth Treatment Infrastructure Enhancement Initiatives Grant (MYTIE), while the program for women is called the Women's Specialty Services (WSS). Also, the Medicaid program of most states has some health insurance coverage for these vulnerable groups in the population.



### **Federal Sources**

The Federal Government has several programs that can help people who have challenges with a form of addiction, such as drug or alcohol addiction. These programs are often implemented in partnership with several entities. They include:


- SAMHSA Grant for public and non-profit organizations
